**Subject: Selection of handloom weavers for allotment of stalls at Dilli Haat from the period starting from 16/5/11 to 15/10/2011.( 10 slots)**

Sir,

Please find enclosed herewith 10 slots alongwith Statewise quota for the period starting from 16/5/2011 to 15/10/2011 in connection with selection of weavers for allotment of stalls at Dilli Haat. There are 42 stalls in Dilli Haat for Office of DC(Handlooms) out of which, it has been decided to allot stalls in the ratio of 60:40 from Handloom Clusters and General weavers. In other words, in every slot 25 weavers will be allotted stalls from Handloom clusters and 17 from outside clusters. The advertisement for selection will be issued shortly in leading regional newspapers. **The last date to receive the applications from the eligible weavers is fixed as 5.5.2011.** The following may be kept in mind while selecting the weavers for allotment of stalls at Dilli Haat.

- All Handloom weavers both from Handloom Clusters and outside clusters are eligible to apply against the quota allocated.
- The handloom weavers should not have participated in Dilli Haat during the last 6 months.
- The identity of handloom weavers shall be verified by the Weavers Service Centres /Cluster Development Executives as the case may be.
- Priority should be given to Sant Kabir awardees, National awardees, National Merit Certificate holders and State awardees.

**The selection of eligible weavers both from general and Handloom Clusters should be made on 9.5.2011 at 2.30 p.m.** by a draw of lot a Committee constituted for the purpose with representatives from State Government, Weaver community etc. and in the presence of weavers who would like to be present at the time of draw of lot. **The applications of weavers from**

**Handloom Clusters must be recommended by the Cluster Development Executive clearly indicating the slot for which they intend to apply to the nearest WSC for selection by draw of lot and not directly either to the Zonal Director, Delhi or to the Head Office.** In case weavers from Handloom Clusters, the helper should be from the Handloom Cluster duly verified and recommended by the concerned CDE.

The selected handloom weavers shall have to report at Dilli Haat with his quality handloom products in the fore-noon of the first day of the fortnight for which he/she is allotted alongwith a scanned copy of recommendation letter by the concerned WSC alongwith photograph. WSC must ensure that the selected weavers both general as well as from Handloom Clusters will be required to deposit a refundable security deposit of Rs.2,000/- with the concerned WSC, which will be refunded to them on successful participation in the selected slot. Non deposit of Rs.2,000/- with the concerned WSC will automatically render them ineligible to participate in the Dilli Haat for the slot selected. The selected handloom weavers shall have to pay rentals to Delhi Tourism & Transport Development Corporation as per the norms of Dilli Haat from time to time, and they shall not be entitled to any TA/DA/Transportation charges etc.

The weaver shall display/sell only those handloom products for which he/she is registered and also demonstrate his/her skill during the stay at Dilli Haat. The weaver and his/her authorized attendant has to be present at his/her stall all the time failing which he/she will be liable for debarment/deregistration.

The Officer incharge must clearly inform the weavers selected that they should sell only the handloom products mentioned in the application/registered for the purpose failing which they will be debarred from participating in Dilli Haat.

The WSCs should send the list of weavers selected for the entire slots in one go alongwith waitlist to Zonal Director, North Zone, WSC, Delhi with a copy to this office within 3-4 days of draw by post as well as e-mail: [singh.dinesh@nic.in](mailto:singh.dinesh@nic.in). Sending names in piecemeal basis will not be entertained. Scanned copy of recommendation letter alongwith photo should also be sent to Zonal Director, North Zone, WSC, Delhi without fail to avoid doctoring /fabrication of documents.

Eligibility conditions:-

- ✓ All handloom weavers can apply.
- ✓ The handloom weaver should not have participated in Dilli Haat during the last **06** months.
- ✓ The identity of handloom weavers shall be verified by the Weavers Service Centres /Cluster Development Executives as the case may be.
- ✓ Priority will be given to Sant Kabir awardees, National Awardees/ National Merit certificate holders/State Awardees.

The interested handloom **weavers** may send their applications to the nearest Weavers Service Centre along-with 3 passport size photographs and proof of Identification indicating address **latest by**

**5.5.2011. The weavers from Handloom Clusters must send their applications clearly indicating the slot for which they intend to apply duly recommended by the Cluster Development Executive to the nearest WSC for selection by draw of lot and not directly either to the Zonal Director, Delhi or to the Head Office.** The applicants are also required to give name and address of the person (helper) who would assist him/her during participation at Dilli Haat and his/her two passport size photographs duly certified by a local Gazetted Officer/concerned WSC. The helper so nominated must preferably be his/her spouse, son/daughter or in all entirely resident of his/her native place. In case weavers from Handloom Clusters, the helper should be from the Handloom Cluster duly verified and recommended by concerned Cluster Development Executive.

The selection of weavers from among those fulfilling the eligibility criteria will be made through draw of lots by the Weavers Service Centre on **9.5.2011 at 2.30 p.m.** in presence of the applicants who wish to be present.

The selected handloom weavers shall have to report at Dilli Haat with his quality handloom products in the fore-noon of the first day of the fortnight for which he/she is allotted alongwith a scanned copy of recommendation letter by the concerned WSC alongwith photograph. The selected weavers both general as well as from Handloom Clusters will be required to deposit a refundable security deposit of Rs.2,000/- with the concerned WSC, which will be refunded to them on successful participation in the selected slot. Non deposit of Rs.2,000/- with the concerned WSC will automatically render them ineligible to participate in the Dilli Haat for the slot selected. The selected handloom weavers shall have to pay rentals to Delhi Tourism & Transport Development Corporation as per the norms of Dilli Haat from time to time, and they shall not be entitled to any TA/DA/Transportation charges etc.

The weaver shall display/sell only those handloom products for which he/she is registered and also demonstrate his/her skill during the stay at Dilli Haat. The weaver and his/her authorized attendant has to be present at his/her stall all the time failing which he/she will be liable for debarment/deregistration.
